Clean Air Day It is National Clean Air Day this year on 17th June 2021. Clean Air Day is the UK's largest air pollution campaign. Every year, air pollution causes up to 36,000 deaths in the UK. The World Health Organisation and the UK Government recognise that air pollution is the largest environmental health risk we face today. Poor air quality causes heart and lung diseases, is linked to low birth weight and children's lung development and may even contribute to mental health issues. St Pancras are welcoming representatives from Suffolk County Council to talk to our Year 5 children about air pollution and a virtual assembly will be shown in all classes. 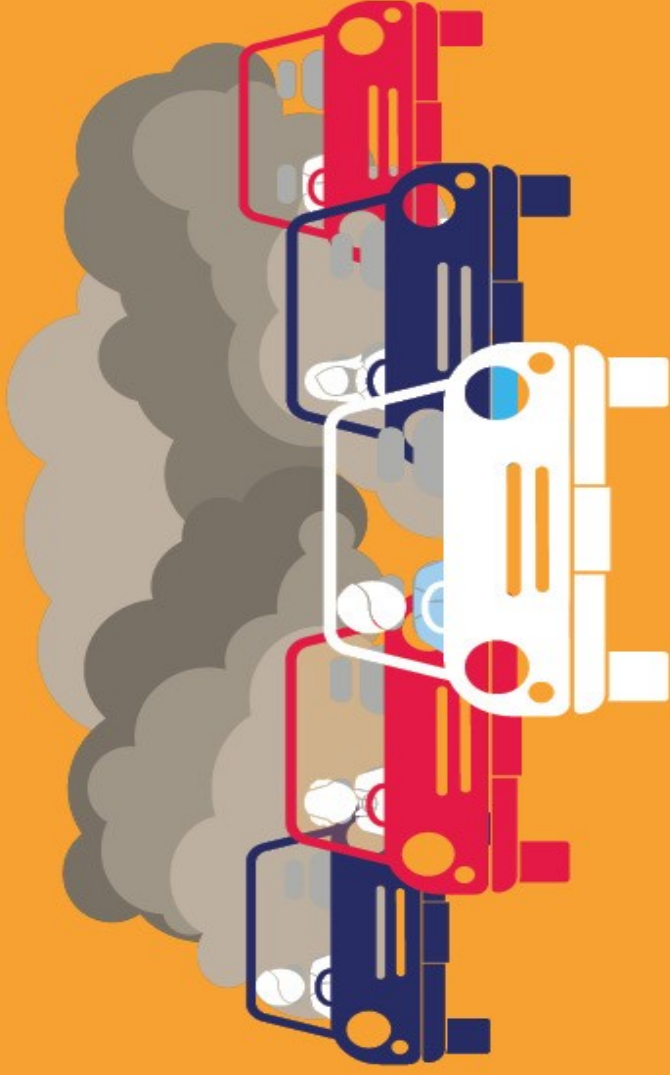
